This document describes the formatting requirements for the abstract of the 2026 Designing Longevity: Work, Welfare and Innovation in Ageing Societies conference proceedings. Please read this document carefully. You may use this document as a template and directly copy/paste your paper content here. It is essential to comply with the formatting requirements; submissions must be in Word format. The abstract paper is limited to one page, including all references.

Please use A4 size paper. Layout margins: Left 2 cm, Right 2 cm, Bottom 2.54 cm, Top 2.54 cm. For the body text, please use a fixed line height of 18pt. Use 12pt BiauKai for Chinese characters and 12pt Times New Roman for English font, justified. The abstract word count should not exceed 500 characters (300 words for English), and the full-text word count is limited to 10,000 characters (6,000 words for English).

Please leave one blank line after the abstract.

Your manuscript must include both Chinese and English titles, which should be in 20pt bold BiauKai (Chinese) / Times New Roman (English). Ensure that capitalization in the title is correct, for example: "The Next Frontier of Information Systems" (Correct), instead of "the next frontier of information systems" (Incorrect). The main body should be in 12pt BiauKai (Chinese) / Times New Roman (English). Section headings (such as "Abstract") should be in 13pt bold BiauKai (Chinese) / Times New Roman (English) and left-aligned. Figures and tables should be placed near the relevant text (or where they are cited in the text). Captions should be in 10pt bold BiauKai (Chinese) / Times New Roman (English), labeled with numbers (e.g., "Table 1"), centered, and placed above the figure or table. The proceedings will be published online, so color figures and tables may be used.

For references, please follow the APA 7th edition format, arranged alphabetically by the author's surname, and place them at the end of the paper.
