Poster Guidelines & Specifications

1. **Poster Size:** A1 portrait format (59.4 cm wide × 84.1 cm high).
2. **Poster Layout:** Presenters may use the template provided by the conference or design their own layout (limited to a single page).
3. **Poster Content:** The content should include, but is not limited to, "Introduction," "Methodology," "Findings (including figures and tables)," and "Conclusions and Recommendations." Adjustments can be made based on the nature of the presentation.
4. **Layout & Design:** Presenters are free to structure the layout based on their research content and presentation needs. It is highly recommended to effectively utilize charts, flowcharts, photographs, text boxes, or other visual designs to enhance readability and visual appeal. Avoid excessively small fonts and maintain appropriate white space to ensure that the title, key highlights, and visual elements can be clearly read from a reasonable distance.
5. **Language:** Posters should be written primarily in English to facilitate reading for international attendees.
6. **Presentation Attendance:** At least one author must be present by their poster during the designated poster session to answer questions. Judges will review the posters, ask questions, and evaluate them for scoring during this period.
